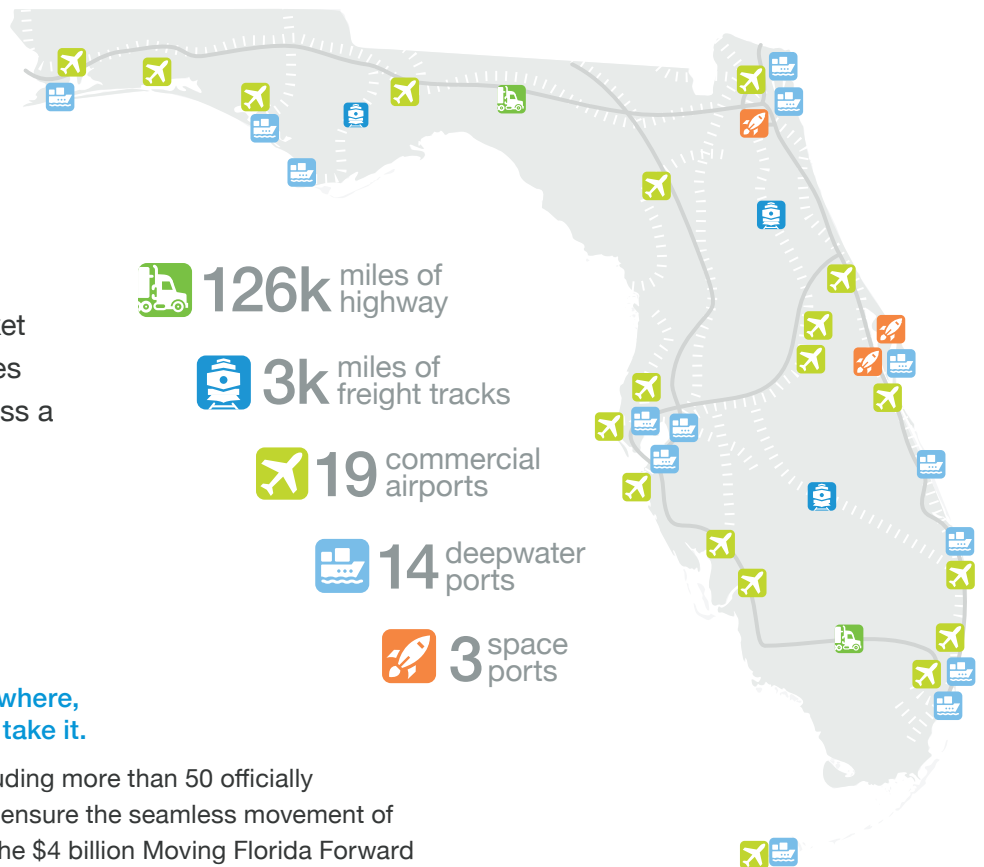

Florida's transportation assets – including more than 50 officially designated multimodal connectors – ensure the seamless movement of people and goods. Investments like the \$4 billion Moving Florida Forward Infrastructure Initiative address congestion, improve safety, ensure the resiliency of our transportation network, and enhance Florida's supply chain and economic growth across the state.

In 2025, Florida businesses exported a record \$78.9 billion in goods, up 8.9% from 2024.



Nearly 60,000 exporting companies or 20% of US exporters, set up their business in Florida. Florida also holds the second-largest foreign trade zone network in the nation, with 20 facilities around the state.

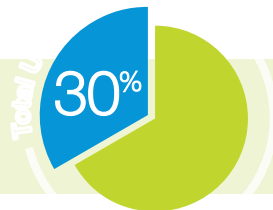
